My priorities, boundaries and next steps

4. Family, wali or trusted-person boundaries

Whom do I want involved, when should that begin, what may they see, and where do my adult privacy and consent remain decisive?

5. Mahr, housing, location and practical plans

At a non-identifying level, what are my expectations or constraints around timing, children, location, housing, work, finances and mahr?

6. Communication, photo privacy and next steps

What pace, photo visibility, contact boundaries, conflict style and next step would feel respectful after mutual interest?
